# SØLØW CHØIR

## CAN YOU TELL ME A LITTLE BIT ABOUT SOLOW CHOIR?

Solow Choir came about in 2020 when I released my first single "Wide Eyes" after having almost 4 years away from releasing and performing anything. I just wanted to have something out in the world and just be able to do the things I loved within music which was to perform and be creative. Strangely, I wanted to go into this project with no expectations but also have the possibility to do anything.

As Solow Choir started gaining momentum, I knew that I wanted to make it more than just a 'solo' project. I wanted to create a community of musicians who shared the same passion for music as I did. It wasn't long before I started collaborating with other artists, and before I knew it, Solow Choir had turned into a collective of like-minded musicians.

The beauty of Solow Choir is that there are no rules or restrictions. I wanted no limitations on style, audience or venue and to be able to perform the songs in their most raw form at a house concert all the way to performing with a full live band in a larger venue.

Our goal is to create a sound that is unique and authentic to us.

We have played shows in small bars and clubs in various cities around the UK, as well as larger venues and festivals. We have released several singles and have even started working on our first full-length album.

It's been an incredible journey so far, and I'm excited to see where it takes us next.

Solow Choiris more than just me, or just a band, it's a community of artists who are passionate about creating and sharing music.

## HOW DID THE IDEA FOR THIS SHOW AT GUISELEY THEATRE COME ABOUT?

I had a conversation with one of the band members about how we could end the year with a bang and all of a sudden we found ourselves with a lot of grand ideas and a venue booked and all the plans were falling into place to begin building up to the show. I wanted to blend some of our more technological aspects of our show such as synths and vocal effects with some more organic and traditional instruments to create a unique, almost cinematic soundtrack. With the logistics of such a show it may very well be a once in a lifetime event for me which makes me want to give it everything I've got and really push the boundaries of what Solow Choir is capable of.

### WHAT'S NEXT FOR SOLOW CHOIR?

With this being the final show of the year, it feels like the perfect opportunity to pause and take a breath. I've been thinking about taking some time to work on new music, create balance, and manage the daily pressures. It's essential for me to find out where everything

fits into my life. This will likely take us up to Summer next year, just in time for festival season. My goal is to have an abundance of fresh songs and return to playing live shows.

## GUISELEY THEATRE

Guiseley theatre is a small venue with a small team but big ambitions. When first opened, the building itself was dedicated 'for the use of the inhabitants of Guiseley, forever' and 156 years later, that is still very much the aim of Guiseley theatre cic. To ensure that this building is there, ready for the community to use.

We are a small, largely voluntary organisation, that is championing the arts, performance and community, trying to make sure that there is space for people to gather, be entertained and inspired on their doorstep, whilst trying to wrestle with a Victorian building and everything that brings, The theatre is a Diamond in the rough with beautiful Victorian features hidden behind 80's decor that we are slowly trying to bring back to life, celebrating the building's rich history, including life as a cinema, a fire station, a town hall and a war hospital.

This transformation is fully funded by community room hire, ticket sales and public donations with no large funding being invested in the building. We have a project list as long as your arm that is waiting for the appropriate funds to be raised to continue the work.

We are also very excited by the massive amount of potential in this building. At present we are working with what we have got, but we recognise that the building as is, is limited, in terms of access, facilities, space and public profile. We have grand plans that involve extending the theatre building to include things like a lift, office space, additional performance spaces and offices.

This is obviously a big project that will take many years, a lot of funding and fundraising. In the meantime, our biggest priority is ensure the building can survive month after month. Bizarrely, we actually did ok over covid. It was a break in the day to day where we could breathe new life into the building and survived off generous donations. What is hitting us hard now is the cost of living crisis. Hospitality and entertainment are the first sectors to be hit when people tighten their belts and we are feeling it! Our average ticket sales have dropped by about 60% per event post covid, and bills have done the opposite. So we are here, and we are fighting but it isn't easy.

So thank you, genuinely for coming out tonight. Your support is appreciated, the drink you bought at the bar really helps us out, the ice cream you purchased in the break keeps us going a little bit longer. Hopefully we'll see you again?

# CAN YOU TELL ME A LITTLE ABOUT YOU AND HOW KYCKER STARTED?

We launched in 2018 after running labels and publishing companies for many years. We wanted a portal that ensured artists could do all the 'boring' music business work they need to do to register tracks and earn money and report in a clear and transparent way, so we spent 2017 developing and



testing version 1 and launched at South by South West in March 2018. Even though we offer distribution and publishing (and if we do both we can then offer sync) all deals are all easy in, easy out, within 28 days. All the agreements are also separate so its not a 360 deal as a 360 deal is no good as they just amplify the 'debt trap' that the old traditional music industry employs.

We definitely are not a "give us £15 and we will release your track" company.

## WHY SHOULD PEOPLE USES KYCKER TO RELEASE THERE MUSIC?

We are a free service as we believe that working on commission shows we are there to help artists. If we don't help and the artists don't earn any revenue from distribution, publishing and/or sync we also don't get paid. We think that artists that use us understand our talent development ethic so stick with us as its is a totally different mode to anyone else. We definitely are not a "give us £15 and we will release your track" company. We know how artists feel about their work and we need to help them reach as big an audience as possible.

# WHAT IS THE GOAL FOR KYCKER AND WHAT DOES THE FUTURE HOLD?

The goal is to keep supporting artists the best way we can and be seen as part of their team. We are based on a DIY music ethic so are keen to ensure artists do not have to dilute their intellectual property and to understand the digital music landscape. There is an awful lot of misinformation out there so as we grow as a company, its our goal to ensure artist are informed, of what's is happening and how to navigate the new music industry to grow and become sustainable. Which is possible, honest!
